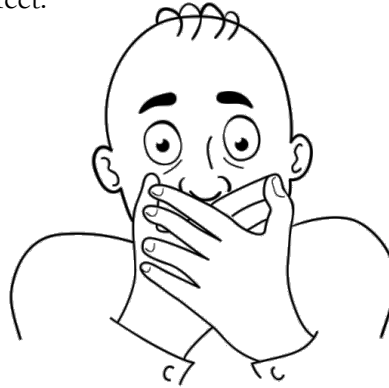


ARE YOU NAKED?
