## Understanding Bible Times

- A Hebrew month began in the middle of a month on our calendar today.
- Years are strictly lunar, broken into 12 new moons (avg. 29.5 days/month, 354 days)
- The sacred year begins with the new moon of spring (between March 22 and April 25)
- For lost time, the calendar has a 13th month (Veadar), 7 times out of 19 years
- A day began at sunset of the previous day
